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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

Ram Nath Nagpal (petitioner No. 1) on attaining the age of superannuation retired as Assistant Registrar on 31.08.2008 and Chetan Parkash (petitioner No. 2) on attaining the age of superannuation retired from the rank of Administrative-cum-Accounts Officer on 03.07.2007 from Chaudhary Charan Singh Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar (in short 'the University). They claim that the respondents have committed a contempt as their case was not considered for promotion to the post of Superintendent from the due dates in the year 1993 with all consequential benefits as per the directions contained in the order dated 06.02.2014 **(Annexure P-1)**.

Upon notice, a reply has been filed by the respondents-University stating that an SLP was preferred in the judgment and order, upon which the reliance has been placed in the order dated 06.02.2014

**(P-1).** The delay, thus, is sought to be explained on that account.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the respondents points out that both the petitioners have since been granted the benefit of promotion as Superintendent under the ratio system w.e.f. 02.08.1993 as also consequent benefit of revision of pay scales, however, the monetary benefits have been restricted towards pensionary benefits only.

The position has been accepted by the counsel for petitioners, however, he submits that the arrears of revised leave encashment remains to be paid.

In response, learned counsel for the respondents-University assures that remaining relief shall be positively calculated and released within next two months.

In view of above and assurance by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition stands disposed of as infructuous.

The respondents-University shall be bound by the aforesaid stand taken.
