The Petitioners were claiming fixation of their seniority in the cadre of Headmasters (Middle School) working with the Education Department, Haryana w.e.f. the dates of their promotion. This Court vide order dated 09.04.2014 directed the grant of benefit to the petitioners within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Although there is a considerable delay in implementing the directions, however, at the time of arguments, learned State Counsel submits that the three petitioners namely Ishwar Singh, Rameshwar Dass and Balwan Singh have been assigned seniority numbers 26, 37 & 38 in the cadre of Headmasters as claimed respectively.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioners concedes that

the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the aforesaid agreed stand of the parties, the present petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
