Notice of motion.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 21.01.2016, passed by the writ court, operative part thereof reads as under:-

“3. Without expressing any opinion on these issues or on the claims on merits, this petition is disposed of with the aforesaid directions. In case, the amounts are found due and interest is payable thereon then the sums of money be disbursed to persons identified after the verification drive is carried out.

4. With these observations and directions, the petition stands disposed of.”

It is contended by counsel for the petitioners that speaking order has been passed. However, payment has not been released pursuant to same.

On asking of the court, Mr. Harsimran Singh Sethi, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice. He submits that needful shall be done at the earliest, in any case not later than six weeks.

In view of statement made by the State counsel, no further direction is necessary. Petition is disposed of. Petitioner shall, however, be at liberty to seek revival of the petition in case any cause of action survives.
