Petitioner is a resident of village Bhatla, Tehsil Hansi, District Hissar and was seeking a direction for conducting of an inquiry regarding irregularities being committed by the depot holders in the public distribution system in the village. His petition bearing CWP No.15866 of 2013 seeking such directions was disposed of vide order dated 25.7.2013 directing the Director Food and Supply to look into the already conducted inquiry report and take a final decision by passing a speaking order.

By filing the present contempt it is alleged that although a speaking order dated 6.11.2013 was passed directing the registration of FIR against the three depot holders found guilty of committing irregularities, however, no FIR has been registered against the erring officials who are in connivance with the said depot holders.

Upon notice replies have been filed.

After hearing learned State Counsel, no further action is warranted as the involvement of the officials, if any, would or would have surfaced in the investigations conducted in the said FIR.

In view of the above, finding no merit in the present contempt petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
