The petitioner/Sub Inspector (Retd.) had filed CWP No.18457 of 2014, seeking directions to the respondents to fix his pay and other emoluments properly, which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 06.09.2014 (**Annexure P-6**), with a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner as contained in the Legal Notice by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply has been filed, wherein it is submitted that two speaking orders dated 05.11.2014 (**Annexure R-1/T**) and 13.02.2015 (**Annexure R-2/T**) have been passed, partially declining the claim of the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the respondents submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the directions were to pass speaking order, which stands complied with.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present contempt petition so as to seek remedy regarding the remaining claim by challenging the aforesaid orders (**R-1** and **R-2**).

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
