Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner could not appear before the respondent as his wife was admitted in the hospital and he ensures the Court that the petitioner will appear before the respondent on the next date of hearing i.e. 18.08.2017 and the complete proforma would be submitted before the respondent authorities.

The contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, in case, the petitioner appears before the respondent authorities on the next date of hearing and submits the complete proforma, the respondent authorities are directed to take action thereupon and consider the same within a period of three months.

In case, the necessary exercise is not done within a period of three months after the next date of hearing i.e on 18.08.2017, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
