Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the amount of interest has been paid to the petitioner and she has also been given appointment.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been appointed against Class-IV post, whereas, the appointment should have been given against Class-III post.

Since the order passed by this Court on 4.5.2012 has been complied with, nothing survives in the contempt petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

However, in case the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, she is at liberty to make representation to the concerned authorities.

In case such representation is filed within a period of one month from today, the respondents are directed to take action on the same within a period of two months thereafter.
