The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 31.08.2015 passed by this Court in CWP No.18267 of 2015, whereby, as per direction issued, the representation which was pending, was to be considered regarding counting of previous service by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In response to notice of motion in the contempt petition, the reply has been filed by Director Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula. He has also placed on record the copy of order with the reply as Annexure R-1, whereby, the claim of the petitioner has been considered and rejected. Although, there is delay in compliance of order and the respondent has tendered an unconditional apology for the said delay.

By considering the submissions made by learned State counsel and also that the claim of the petitioner has been rejected and the order has been passed, the contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
