Vide order dated 26.4.2017, learned counsel for the respondent-State submitted that fresh order dated 22.4.2017 has been passed while withdrawing the previous speaking order dated 22.7.2015.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that claim of the petitioners has been accepted and necessary benefits will be released shortly. She has also filed an affidavit of respondent No.3 in this regard in Court today and the same is taken on record.

Keeping in view the submission made by learned counsel for the respondent-State and the fact that order passed by this Court has been complied with by considering the claim of the petitioners, the present contempt petition is disposed of.

However, the respondents are directed to release the necessary benefits to the petitioners as per their entitlement within a period of four weeks.

In case, non-compliance of the order is there, the petitioners are at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
