On the asking of court, Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.A.G,
Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 2.8.2017 passed by
the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“ The instant petition is disposed of with
direction to respondent-authorities to consider the
premature release of petitioner under prevalent rules
and pass a speaking order within a period of six weeks,
from the date of receipt of copy of this order. However,
the petitioner will be at liberty to file fresh petition for
the same cause of action, if needs so arise.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that in case
speaking order has not been passed till now, needful shall be done at the
earliest in any case not later than two weeks.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. In case,

fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, exemplary costs shall be imposed which would be deducted from the salary of the officer(s) responsible for delay/non compliance.
