JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner has filed the instant Contempt Petition under Sections 10/11 of the Contempt of Court Act, 1971 against the respondents for punishing them for committing contempt of court for not obeying the directions issued by this Court vide orders dated 15.12.2016 & 21.12.2016 Annexures **P-1 & P-2** passed in CWP No.24584 of 2016 regarding issuance of necessary certificates prayed in the application of the petitioner.

On the previous date of hearing i.e. 20.02.2017 following order was passed:-

“ *Keeping in view the facts of the case, notice has also to be issued to respondent nos.1 & 3.*

Notice to respondent nos.1 & 3.

On the asking of the Bench, Mr. Manish Kumar Singla, Advocate is directed to accept notice on behalf of respondent nos.1 & 3 who is already representing the private college in the pending writ petition bearing CWP No.24584 of 2016.

Let necessary replies by both the University and College authorities be filed before the next date of hearing.

List on 03.03.2017.

Let the necessary migration certificate and certificate of passing of BDS Ist Year-2015/16 session be issued by the University and College forthwith. The same however would be subject to the ultimate decision of the writ petition.

To be shown in urgent. ”

At the time of hearing today, learned Counsel for the respondents submits that necessary compliance of order dated 20.02.2017 has been made.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner also concedes that the necessary migration certificate and Certificate of passing of BDS Ist Year 2015-16 session has been issued by the respondent no.2-University and respondent no.3 College in compliance of order dated 15.12.2016/20.02.2017.

In view of the above, present contempt petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
