The petitioner had filed CWP No.17415 of 2015 seeking directions to the Chief Administrator, HUDA to hold the inquiry and to take appropriate action against one Tejinder Kumar, respondent No.4 therein, as directed by order dated 04.10.2011 (**Annexure P-1**), passed by the Financial Commissioner, Town & Country Planning, Haryana. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 21.08.2015 (**Annexure P-3**) with a direction to the Chief Administrator, HUDA to comply with the order dated 04.10.2011. It was further directed that the order should be passed after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and private respondent No.4 therein, Tejinder Kumar. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the parties submit that the present petition has become infructuous as the aforesaid directions passed by this Court have since been complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
