JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The petitioner was promoted as Head Mistress vide order dated 23.07.2013. She was claiming *ante-date* promotion as Head Mistress w.e.f. 18.01.2002 and also consideration for further promotion as Principal w.e.f. 20.07.2007 i.e. the date with effect from her juniors were promoted.

This Court, vide order dated 14.08.2015 passed in CWP No.16781 of 2015 (**Annexure P-1**) seeking the aforesaid claim, directed the respondents to pass a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply has been filed asserting that the required relief has since been granted to the petitioner as per the orders dated 11.07.2016 (**Annexure R-1**) and 14.09.2016 (**Annexure R-2**).

Learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes that the aforesaid directions have been complied with.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.
Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
