On the asking of court, Mr.Rohit Arya, AAG, Haryana accepts
notice on behalf of State of Haryana.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 9.5.2014 passed by
this court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“In the light of the above, the present writ
petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to
file a revision petition before the Government under
Rule 16.32 of Punjab Police Rules, 1934. If such a
representation is filed within a period of three weeks
from today, the same shall be considered and decided
within a period of three months from the date of
submission of such representation.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that in case
revision is still pending, the authority shall be asked to decide the same
expeditiously in any case not later than 3 months.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary.

Disposed of.

In case, fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, apart from proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, it shall consider imposition of exemplary costs.
