On the asking of court, Mr.Aditya Sharda, AAG, Punjab
accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 1.6.2017 passed by
this court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“This petition is disposed of with a
direction to respondent No.3-Secretary, Regional
Transport Authority, Bathinda to consider legal notice
Annexure P-5 dated 15.1.2017 within a period of three
months after the receipt of certified copy of the order.

It will be the duty of the petitioner to
communicate the copy of the order along with copy of
the petition with annexures to the notice of the above
said authority.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that in case
representation/legal notice is still pending with the authority, decision
thereon shall be taken at the earliest in any case not later than one month.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary.

Disposed of.

In case, fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, exemplary costs shall be imposed which would be deducted from the salary of the officer(s) responsible for delay/non compliance.
