On the asking of court, Mr.Aditya Sharda, AAG, Punjab
accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 30.8.2017 passed by
this court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“Without commenting on the merits of the
case or the entitlement of the petitioner for the
abovesaid relief and keeping in view the fact that the
matter is still pending consideration, the present writ
petition is disposed of with direction to respondent no.2
to take a decision on the representation dated 17.8.2017
(Annexure P-5) as to whether the petitioner is liable to
be exonerated or not within a period of 2 months from
the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that needful shall
be done at the earliest in any case not later than one month.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary.

In case, fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, exemplary costs shall be imposed which would be deducted from the salary of the officer(s) responsible for delay/non compliance.
