Learned counsel for the respondent-State on instructions from Mr. P.K. Mahapatra, Additional Chief Secretary, Public Health Engineering Department, Haryana submits that the services of the petitioners have already been regularized and consequential benefits will be released to them within a period of six weeks from today subject to the decision of SLP pending before Hon'ble the Apex Court, wherein, notice has already been issued.

Keeping in view the submission made by learned counsel for the respondent-State, the present contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pay all consequential benefits to the petitioners within a period of six weeks from today subject to outcome of SLP.
