On the asking of court, Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.A.G.,

Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 19.7.2017 passed by
the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“Instant petition is disposed of with the
direction to respondent No.2 to consider the grievances
unfolded by the petitioner in application dated 21.3.2017
(Annexure P-2) and take a decision within a period of
three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of
this order. In case, the concerned authority comes to the
conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the benefits
claimed by him, the same be disbursed to him within a
period of two months thereafter.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that in case

aforesaid order has not been complied with till now, steps would be taken

to comply with the order at the earliest in any case not later than one month.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. In case, fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, exemplary costs shall be imposed which would be deducted from the salary of the officer(s) responsible for delay/non compliance.
