On the asking of court, Mr.Rohit Arya, AAG, Haryana accepts
notice on behalf of State of Haryana.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 19.5.2017 passed by
the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“Accordingly, both the writ petitions are
allowed. Respondents are directed to reimburse the
medical bills of the petitioners to the tune of
Rs.7,05,936/- in CWP No.4892-2010 and Rs.1,77,818/-
in CWP Nos.4647-2016 along with interest @ 9% per
annum from the date of filing of petition till the payment
within a period of two months from the date of receipt of
a certified copy of this order.”

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that in case no
appeal is pending against the aforesaid order, steps would be taken to
comply with the order at the earliest in any case not later than one month.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. In case, fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, exemplary costs shall be imposed which would be deducted from the salary of the officer(s) responsible for delay/non compliance.
