The petitioner had retired on attaining the age of superannuation w.e.f. 31.07.2002 from the rank of Head Mistress from the Secondary Education Department, Haryana. The claim of the petitioner for counting her previous service from 10.05.1971 to 24.01.1974 (2 years, 8 months and 15 days), rendered in a Privately Managed Government Aided School before her appointment on regular basis in the Government Service towards qualifying service for grant of pension was directed by this Court vide order dated 18.08.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) by passing a speaking order within six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, reply on behalf of the respondents has been filed, which is taken on record. Copy of the same has been furnished to learned Counsel for the petitioner. The necessary relief is stated to have been sanctioned, however, the arrears of revised pension are yet to be released.

Learned Counsel for the respondents submits that within two months, even the arrears would be released.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition stands disposed as infructuous.

The petitioner is given liberty to revive the present contempt petition in case there is any default on the part of the respondents in fully implementing the directions dated 18.08.2015 (**P-1**), passed by this Court.
