Short reply by way of an affidavit of Sangita , Under Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Finance on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

It has been mentioned in the affidavit that in compliance of order dated 28.7.2015 passed in C.W.P. No. 15197 of 2015, the Department of Finance vide letter dated 20.7.2017 (Annexure R-2/1) has given its concurrence to Administrative Department to grant pension and other pensionary benefits to the petitioner.

Since the order passed by this Court has been complied with and the relief in principal has been granted, nothing survives in the present contempt petition and the same is disposed of.

However, the respondents are directed to release the payment within a period of two months.

In case non-compliance of the order is there, the petitioner is at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
