DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

In pursuance to directions issued by this Court, the re-survey was conducted and a list of all candidates was prepared. It was also mentioned that the candidates were to submit their applications to be ascertained by the respondent authorities as a number of candidates were there and some of their family members also submitted their applications. Just to ascertain the veracity of those candidates and also the genuineness of their claim, a direction was issued to the respondents to make allotment as per list prepared in the re-survey.

From the perusal of petition and by considering the arguments, nowhere, it is the case that the petitioners submitted their applications. Even one of the petitioners was not petitioner in the earlier petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is having a

copy of the application as well as the list of re-survey where the names of both the petitioners are there.

In view of facts as mentioned above and the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, in case, a representation is made by the petitioners within a period of one month by showing that their names were there in the re-survey conducted subsequently and they submitted their applications then the respondent authorities are directed to take decision thereupon within a period of two months thereafter in view of directions issued by the Division Bench of this Court. However, in case, they are found to be eligible their claim be considered and in case, not eligible then a speaking order be passed.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
