The petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the present contempt petition for non-compliance of order dated 04.12.2015 passed in Review Application No.462 of 2015, which was filed in CWP No.12563 of 2015.

The present contempt petition has been filed only on the ground that the order has not been passed in accordance with law.

On perusal of order dated 04.12.2015, it appears that the review application filed by the petitioner was dismissed but the liberty was granted to him to avail such other remedy as is available to him in accordance with law. It was also observed that the Debts Recovery Tribunal has seized of the proceedings against the order passed by the District Magistrate and it shall be decided without being influenced by any of the findings recorded by the Division Bench in the writ petition. In pursuance of that directions, order dated 10.06.2016 has been passed. The petitioner was at liberty to challenge

that order but instead of challenging the same, he has approached this Court
by way of filing the present contempt petition.

Since the remedy is there to challenge the said order, no ground
is made out to initiate the contempt proceedings.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.
