Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of order passed by this Court on 27.11.2014, the necessary payment has been released to the petitioners, whereas, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that much delay has been caused in releasing the payment.

Since the compliance of order dated 27.11.2014 is there, it cannot be said that there is willful disobedience of said order but delay has been caused and as such, a cost of ₹ 20,000/- is imposed upon the respondent to be paid to the petitioners by way of demand draft within a period of one month.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
