JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner-Subhash Chander has retired on attaining the age of superannuation on 31.07.2014 from Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala in the rank of Junior Assistant. His retiral benefits could not be paid due to the financial crunch conflicting the Corporation.

At the time of hearing, an additional affidavit dated 13.12.2016 of Shri Ravinder Singh, Managing Director, Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala, has been filed, wherein it is stated that the entire retiral dues for a sum of Rs. 15,55,959/- + 68,083 stand paid to the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid stand, learned counsel for the petitioner concedes that no further action is warranted in the present case.

Dismissed as infructuous.

The respondent shall be bound by the aforesaid stand taken.

In case, there is some factual error, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present contempt.
