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I have considered the submissions made by the counsel for the
parties.

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has not been granted the first higher standard increment
w.e.f. 01.01.1994. This contention of the learned council for the petitioner

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appears to be incorrect in the light of the office order dated 31.01.2013 (Annexure R-1) (at page 64 of the paper-book) where it has specifically been stated that first higher standard increment has been granted to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.01.1994. Petitioner, if not satisfied, may initiate appropriate proceedings by filing execution proceedings as these aspects cannot be gone into in the contempt proceedings.

The contempt petition stands disposed of accordingly.
