On the asking of court, Mr.Gaurav Jindal, Addl.A.G., Haryana
accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana.

Petitioner alleges violation of order dated 18.7.2017 passed by
this court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

“In the circumstances, the police is directed to
conclude the enquiry in the aforesaid matter within three
months and submit its final report to the appropriate
authority, a copy of which he supplied to the petitioner. If the
petitioner is not satisfied with the case enquiry report, it shall
always open to petitioner to file a criminal complaint before
the competent court of the same is permissible under the law.

In view of the above noted observation, present
petition stands disposed of.”

Learned State counsel submits that in case enquiry is still
pending, the authority shall endeavour to conclude the same at the earliest
in any case not later than one month.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary.

In case, fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner to invoke the contempt jurisdiction of this court, exemplary costs shall be imposed which would be deducted from the salary of the officer(s) responsible for delay/non compliance.
