accepts notice.

Petitioner allege violation of order dated 03.08.2017, passed by
the writ court. Operative part thereof reads as under:-

*“In the light of what has been discussed above, instant writ
petition is allowed and impugned order dated July 09, 2016 is set
aside. The respondents are directed to make the payment of arrears
of pension from the date it was stopped alongwith interest @9% per
annum till the date it is actually paid, within a period of two months
from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this judgment.”*

Learned State counsel submits that in case no appeal has been
preferred against the aforesaid order, same shall be complied with at the
earliest, in any case, not later than 02 months.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further
direction is necessary. In case, fresh cause of action accrues to the petitioner

to invoke contempt jurisdiction of this court, apart from proceedings under the Act, this court shall consider imposition of punitive costs to be recovered from the salary of the officers responsible for the delay/non-compliance.
