The petitioner had filed CWP No.16550 of 2015 seeking directions to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as per Legal Notice dated 02.09.2013, as also to grant the pensionary benefits. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 12.08.2015 with a direction to the respondent(s) to take decision on the legal notice by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done within the stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, reply has been filed asserting that the necessary relief has since been granted to the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner concedes the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
