Earlier petitioner filed COCP No.500 of 2003 wherein
following order was passed:-

*“Counsel for the petitioner states that the arrears
have not been paid to the petitioner after fixation of
petitioner's pay with effect from 02.11.1968.*

*Counsel for the respondent submits that the pay
fixation table of the petitioner with effect from 02.11.1968 in
the Grade, as per the order passed by this Court from time to
time will be sent to the counsel for the petitioner within a
period of four weeks from today.*

*In case, the petitioner is not satisfied with the pay
fixation table as has been mentioned therein and supplied to
the petitioner, he may avail of his remedy in accordance with
law.*

*The present contempt petition is disposed of
accordingly. Rule discharged.”*

In pursuance of aforesaid order the calculation was not made.

Thereafter petitioner filed the present contempt petition wherein notice of
motion was issued. In the order passed in earlier contempt petition it was

mentioned that in case the petitioner is not satisfied with the pay fixation table mentioned therein and supplied to the petitioner, he may avail the appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

Earlier calculation was not provided to the petitioner but now along with additional affidavit, the details of the amount paid to petitioner and deposited in his account has been prepared on the basis of statement of the bank.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that calculations have not properly been made and petitioner is entitled for pay fixation since 02.11.1968 which has not been granted. In case the petitioner is not satisfied with the benefits already granted, he is at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy available to him.
