JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Learned Single Judge, vide order dated 09.10.2015 in CWP No.21657 of 2015 (**Annexure P-3**) directed the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) to take steps on the recommendations sent by the Punjab Government for consideration of the case of late Sh. Balwant Singh/husband of petitioner No.1 and Jit Singh/petitioner No.2 for placing them in the select list of 1989 for appointment to the IPS Cadre. The said exercise was to be conducted within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice, the respondents have placed on record a copy of the order dated 19.01.2017, which is taken on record as **Mark 'A'**, whereby due compliance of the directions contained in the order dated 09.10.2015 has been shown.

In view of the aforesaid development, learned Counsel for the petitioners concedes that the present petition has become infructuous.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.

It is hoped that the Punjab Government would further not delay the grant of arrears of revised pension etc.
