The prayer of the petitioner in CWP No.21961 of 2014 was for issuance of direction to the respondent authorities including the Director, Consolidation, Haryana to start and complete the consolidation proceedings in respect of its village expeditiously and in a time-bound manner.

The said petition was disposed of with a direction to the Director, Consolidation, Haryana-respondent No.3 to take cognizance of the legal notice received on behalf of the petitioner and take appropriate decision in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

As no action was taken by respondent No.3, the present

contempt petition was filed.

Notice of motion in the case was issued on 29.04.2015.

Without filing any reply to the contempt petition, learned State counsel, on instructions from Sh. Jai Kumar, Kanungo, submits that consolidation proceedings have been started and the same will be completed within a period of two years.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned State counsel that consolidation proceedings have been started and the same are likely to be concluded, the respondents are directed to complete the same within a period of one year.

However, in case, the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner or the consolidation proceedings of the village of the petitioner are not completed within a period of one year, the petitioner-Gram Panchayat is at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
