DAYA CHAUDHARY J.(Oral)

As per order dated 04.08.2016 passed in CWP No.15554 of 2016, the claim of the petitioner was to be considered as early as possible, but not later than two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. However, the order was not complied with within a period of two months, as it was received vide diary dated 01.09.2016. The petitioner had to file the present contempt petition wherein notice was issued to the respondents on 13.01.2017 with a direction to comply with the said order within a period of one month, failing which, the respondent was directed to come present in Court on the date fixed.

The order has been passed on 09.02.2017 meaning thereby after a period of 06 months. Although, all efforts were made to justify the delay, but the same is not convincing and no reason was assigned why the order was not passed within the specified time and no such application has been moved for extension of time before this Court in this regard.

Since the order has been passed but with delay, the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the same, if he is aggrieved in any manner. However, for

causing the delay, an amount of Rs.25,000/- is imposed as costs upon the respondent and the same be paid to the petitioner by way of bank draft within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
