JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is a sole proprietorship firm and is engaged in business of liquor with L-1, L-2 and L-14A licences for a particular area in the year 2016-17, for sale of liquor as a wholesale dealer, retail for IMFL and countrymade liquor respectively. The petitioner is alleged to have filed a writ petition bearing CWP No. 2286 of 2017 seeking exemption from payment of licence fee for certain portions of the month of April 2016 and October 2016 for the non-supply of liquor stock by the Government required to be lifted by the petitioner-licence holder. In the said writ petition, an interim order dated 08.02.2017 (**Annexure P-1**) was passed, whereby protection to some extent was extended and the petition now stands reserved, awaiting judgment.

Since the claim benefit in terms of the interim order dated 08.02.2017 (P-1) was not being extended, the present contempt has been filed.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
