Reply filed by State counsel by way of affidavit of Sarabjit Singh Toor, Distt. Education Officer (S.E.), Barnala is on record.

In para No.3 of the said reply, it is mentioned that in compliance of the order, the selection grade of ₹ 120-175, earlier granted to the petitioner has been restored. The corresponding entries have been recorded in the service book of the petitioner. The revised pension case of the petitioner was sent to the office of Accountant General, Punjab vide letter dated 21.03.2017 and revised pension payment order has also been issued vide letter dated 28.04.2017. It is also mentioned that the petitioner has to get revised pension directly from the Treasury Office. It has also been mentioned that the difference of revised gratuity has been paid to the

petitioner. The amount which has been deducted has also been returned with interest @ 12% per annum. The details of the amount has also been mentioned in the aforesaid para.

Since the compliance of the order has been made, nothing survives in the petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

In case the petitioner is still aggrieved, he is at liberty to move representation before the competent authority.
