In the execution proceedings bearing No. 325/3541 of 2014, learned Additional District Judge, Amritsar, vide its order dated 03.10.2015 (**Anenxure P-1**), directed the Judgment Debtors (JDs) to make the payment of decretal amount to the decree holders (petitioners herein) within one month from the date of order.
