AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Having gone through the order passed by this Court in the writ petition as also the reply filed by the respondents in the present contempt petition, this Court is of the considered view that the direction issued by this Court in the writ petition, which was preferred by the petitioner, stands complied with. The claim of the petitioner has been duly considered and out of seven petitioners, services of three petitioners have been regularized including that of the present petitioner in the contempt petition, however, the claim of four petitioners, namely, Balbir Singh, Hans Raj, Kamlesh Kumari and Sukkan Wati, has been found to be not covered by the policy of regularization dated 11.11.2003. A speaking order dated 01.05.2017 (Annexure R-1) has been passed by the Director, Secondary Education, Haryana.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous. Disposed of as such. Any of the person(s), who is aggrieved of the order dated 01.05.2017 (Annexure R-1) which has been passed by the respondents, may avail of his/her remedy in accordance with law.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
