The respondent-Mithan Lal (petitioner therein) had filed CRM-M No.17764 of 2016 against the order of the Court below, directing him to desist from carrying on the business from his residence. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 01.12.2016 and the respondent-Mithan Lal (petitioner therein) was granted 15 days' time to implement the order of the authorities. Since the needful was not done, hence the present contempt petition.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the respondent submits that her client has submitted an affidavit dated 24.03.2017 before the S.D.M., Rohtak that he has closed the “Aawa”, in compliance of the aforesaid order dated 01.12.2016 and, therefore, the present contempt petition has become infructuous.

In response, learned Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the aforesaid affidavit, taken on record as **Mark 'A'** and concedes that the present contempt petition has become infructuous.

In view of the above, no further action is warranted.

Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
