The petitioners filed CWP No.21536 of 2015 for issuance of direction to the respondents to make entry in the revenue record as per order dated 08.02.1989 passed by respondent No.2 in pursuance of provisions of 7.32 of Land Records Manual.

While disposing the said petition the following order was passed :-

“Without expressing any views on merits, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to ascertain the correct facts and if there is no legal impediment or if so required in law, take the follow up action pursuant to the above stated order within six months.”

When said order was not complied with, the petitioners filed the present contempt petition.

In response to the notice of motion, reply has been filed, which is on record. Subsequently, an affidavit has also been filed by Ms. Poonam Babbar, Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector IInd Grade, Gannaur, Distt. Sonipat. In Para No.5 of the said affidavit it has been mentioned that order dated 08.10.2015 has already been complied with by the concerned officer by entering and sanctioning mutation No.873 on 22.05.2017, which is annexed as Annexure R-2 with the said affidavit.

Since compliance of the order has been made, the present contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.

In case the petitioners are still aggrieved in any manner, they are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.
