Learned counsel for respondent No. 4 submits that keeping in view the stand taken in the written statement, whenever any recruitment will be made from open market, the requisite number of seats shall be kept reserved for persons with disability and efforts will also be made to clear the backlog of the posts in that category, nothing survives in the present contempt petition.

However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved at the time of filling up the posts or issuance of any advertisement, they are at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
