JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner is a Lecturer in Mathematics and was posted in the office of District Education Officer, Sonapat on 6.8.2016 on transfer from Govt. Senior Secondary School, Ganaur, District Sonapat. The transfer order was rescinded vide order dated 08.08.2016 leaving the petitioner to file CWP No.166601 of 2016 wherein vide interim order dated 17.08.2016 (P-1) interim stay was granted whereby the petitioner was to continue to be retained at Sonapat.

It is alleged that in violation of the aforesaid interim order dated 17.08.2016, a fresh transfer order dated 21.12.2016 was passed posting him at Garhi Jhanjjara, District Sonapat. The petitioner filed a fresh CWP No.936 of 2017 wherein interim order dated 19.01.2017 was passed whereby the transfer of the petitioner was stayed.

It is the aforesaid backdrop the contempt has been filed alleging that the interim direction dated 17.08.2016 (**P-1**) has been violated.

It is not in dispute that both the aforesaid writ petitions are still pending adjudication before this Court.

Upon notice a reply has been filed by stating that inadvertent mistake had occurred due to system error while passing the order dated 21.12.2016. An unconditional apology has been tendered.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.
