Three *Panches*-petitioners had filed CWP No.23194 of 2016 aggrieved against the inaction on part of the Revisional Authority in deciding expeditiously the revision petition filed by the petitioners against the order dated 19.10.2016 appointing Administrator of the Village to undertake the development works. The plea was that in the presence of the elected *Panches* the Administrator was not required to execute the works.

This Court vide order dated 09.11.2016 disposed of the writ petition by directing the Revisional Authority to decide the pending revision expeditiously in accordance with law, while proceeding to stay the impugned order dated 19.10.2016 during the pendency of the revision and till the passing of the order by the revisional order. The Revisional Authority vide order dated 23.11.2016 disposed off the revision as infructuous as the term of the Administrator had already come to an end.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances it is submitted that the Revisional Authority has committed contempt of the order dated 27.10.2016 passed by this Court as no speaking order was passed. The argument is totally misplaced as by that time the Revisional Authority decided the matter, the issue had become academic as the term of the appointment of the Administrator stood expired.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
