Main Case

This revision petition is arising out of orders dismissing application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC and refusing to grant temporary injunction. Plaintiff is only praying for a restrained order against the defendant to alienate the property. Alienation of the property if any during the pendency of the suit is governed by rule of lis pendens.

The suit was instituted on 11.12.2012, learned counsel for the parties had informed that the trial of the case is at fag end and the case is now fixed for rebuttal and arguments.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is disposed of with request to the learned trial Court to dispose of the main suit itself within a period of two months from the date of receipt of

certified copy of this order.
