Petitioners ten in number are working as JBT teachers with the Department of Elementary Education, Haryana. They were transferred vide order dated 17.09.2016 but could not join their place of posting due to other incumbent still occupying the said vacancy. Resultantly their pay could not be released. Petitioners along with 17 other teachers filed CWP No.27369 of 2016 claiming release of salary. The said petition was disposed of vide order dated 09.10.2017 with direction to decide their representation within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Since the needful was not done within a stipulated time, hence the present contempt petition.

Upon notice a reply by way of affidavit dated 21.03.2017 of Sh.

S.S. Phulia, Director Elementary Education Haryana has been filed. Along

with the reply orders have been placed on record to show that the salaries of the petitioners which stood stopped for last four months has been ordered to be released.

In view of the stand of the respondents, no further proceedings are warranted in the contempt petition.

Dismissed.
