This contempt petition has been filed to initiate contempt proceedings against the Arbitrator. The ground taken is that earlier the matter had been adjourned sine-die since the record was not produced before the Arbitrator and now even though the situation regarding the record remains the same he has gone ahead in a most high-handed manner and decided the case in the absence of any record.

In my opinion, even if all the facts alleged by the petitioner are taken to be correct yet at the most it can be said that a wrong order has been passed for which the petitioner has other remedies and it cannot be said that there is contempt of Court.

Consequently the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
