The tenant is in revision directed against the order dated 21.01.2015,
passed by learned Appellate Authority, Amritsar, whereby mesne profits have been
determined at the rate of Rs.6500/- per month, being highly excessive.

present revision petition has become infructuous as the Appellate Authority,
Amritsar has since decided the appeal in favour of the landlord and against the
