The petitioners have filed the present contempt petition for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent on the allegations that the order dated 23.2.2016, passed by this Court requiring the respondent to consider the legal notice dated 15.10.2015, by passing a speaking order has been disobeyed. The order which is sought to be implemented is dated 23.2.2016.

A perusal of the order indicates that the said order was passed without any notice to the respondent. In view of said circumstances, it would be debatable if there has been any wilful disobedience of the order passed by this Court. A perusal of the petition indicates that there is no material on the record indicating that the order had actually been communicated specifically to the respondent requiring the respondent to comply with the same. The legal notice which has been appended with the contempt petition Annexure P2 is dated 15.10.2015 i.e. of a date prior to the date of order passed by this Court.

In view of said circumstances, this petition is disposed of as pre-mature with liberty to the petitioners to approach the concerned authority by communicating the order passed by this Court. In case no action is taken or there is any wilful disobedience by any authority, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again.
