This is an application seeking withdrawal of the company petition. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that a compromise has been arrived at between the Directors. He further submits that FIR Nos. 53 dated 17.05.2010 & FIR No. 58 dated 11.04.2012 registered in the matter were quashed on the basis of compromise by the coordinate bench vide order dated 14.09.2017 passed in CRM M-16053 of 2017 & CRM M-16050 of 2017 respectively.
