Vide order dated 04.09.2015, a direction was issued to respondent No.1 to take a decision on the recommendation with regard to removal of anomaly expeditiously, preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order. When the order was not complied with within the specified period, the petitioner has to file the present contempt petition before this Court wherein notice of motion was issued.

Now after filing of the contempt petition, order dated 27.07.2017 has been passed whereas order was to be complied with upto 03.12.2015. Although every effort has been made by the respondent to show as to why delay has occurred. After disposal of the writ petition no application was moved for extension of time and now the order has been passed without any delay.

In case the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to avail appropriate remedy. An amount of Rs.10,000/- is imposed as

costs upon the respondents to be paid to the petitioner by way of draft within a period of one month by the Officer/Official from his own pocket who was responsible for causing the delay.
