Petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 22.7.2016 passed by the writ court. Reply by way of affidavit of Ashok Sharma, Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering Division, Panchkula-respondent No.3 was filed on 11.5.2017. *Para 3* thereof reads as under: -

“That in compliance with the aforesaid orders of Hon'ble High Court, the services of the petitioner has been regularized w.e.f. 29.7.2011 vide office order Endst No. 7894 dated 8.5.2017 by the Superintendent Engineer, Public Health Engineering Circle, Ambala. Copy of regularization order is attached as Annexure R-1 for kind perusal of the Hon'ble Court. It is submitted that back wages in pursuance to this regularization order will be paid to the petitioner within the next three months. In view of the above, the order dated 22.7.2016 of the Hon'ble High Court has been complied with.”

Learned State counsel further submits that arrears due to the petitioner shall be released to him at the earliest in any case not later than three months.

In view of above, no cause of action survives in this petition. Same is disposed of as having been rendered infurctuous.

Rule is discharged.
